Jeffrey A. Rembaum, Esq. Named to Legal Elite

The process for Legal Elite begins with attorneys who are asked to name those whom they hold in the highest regard or would recommend to others. A panel of previous Legal Elite winners, representing different practice areas in cities across the state, reviews the selection process and the list of finalists.

Each year since 2012, Rembaum also has been selected to the Florida Super Lawyers list. No more than five percent of the lawyers in the state are selected by the research team at Super Lawyers to receive this honor.
